Season Recap

- Despite losing 16 nights to rainouts, it was a pretty successful season.
- Great turnout for the Early Bird Tournament (10u 8 teams (7 local), 12u 16 teams (11 local), 14u 12 teams (9 local) and 16/18u 12 teams (11 local))
- 9 teams from our league placed in the top four in their divisions at the State Tournament. With two teams bringing home a State Championship (16U Crush & 10U SWAT).
- First year of with online registration went well.

- Very successful National Tournament. Kudos to the National Tournament committee for putting on a topnotch tournament.

Buildings

- New concession stand and bathrooms completed by Fields 5&6.
- Security lights fixed and new ones added on the outside of Crow's Nest and dugouts.
- Leaking toilets and drinking fountain fixed.
- New water heater installed.
- Equipment purchased for concession stands through renegotiated Pepsi contract.
- New LED lights in bathrooms with motion sensors.
- Batting shed received some decorating.
- Outdoor cooking area to keep spectators safe during cooking.

Grounds and Fields

- Scoreboards updated and fixed through renegotiated Pepsi contract.
- New dirt added to Fields 5&6 (big thanks to those who volunteered their time and equipment to move dirt onto the fields).
- Transitions where the infield meets the outfield cut out so there was no more lips to prevent players from taking bad hops to the face.
- New field prep protocols put in place to keep fields in good playing condition.
- Crow's Nest was organized, straightened up out of date items discarded. This allowed extra space for concession product to be under lock and key and easier for staff to do inventory.
- New backstop pads.

Moving Forward

- Fix drainage problems around shed and third base side of field 1. City will be putting in drainage tiles and running them to the storm drains at both areas.
- Will be getting painting bids to get doors, windows and railings to match the color of the new concession stand along with getting the sheds painted.
- Will be getting bids to get dugouts wrapped with sheet metal.
- Working with the city to fix the heaving concrete around the Crow's Nest.
- Looking into options to get a playground built in the complex.
- Looking into options for a memorial to honor these requests.
- We are in the process of moving the equipment room to the new concession stand. Most teams who use the equipment are our 6U and 8U teams and they play at those fields. It is presently used for umpires to change and they requested to be moved back to the Crow's Nest because the new room is too small.
